Mr. Warren J. Jones, Jr. quietly went home to be with the Lord, Sunday morning, September 2, 2018. He was born in Greensboro, NC on September 21, 1946.

Warren was a member of Bass Chapel United Methodist Church and was baptized by Rev. Belvin Jessup (former Pastor of Bass Chapel United Methodist Church). He sung in the youth choir and was president of the usher board. He was an active member of the Youth Fellowship Ministry led by Mrs. Willie Mae Jones.

Warren was recognized early in childhood by his peers that he was academically smart. His teachers would talk about his uncanny ability to master any skill of learning that was set before him. His parents were advised to seek higher education for this gifted young man.

He graduated from James B. Dudley High School in 1964 with a full scholarship to NC A&T State University. In 1968, he graduated from NC A&T State University with a BS degree in Sociology and in 1974 with a Masters degree in Counseling Education. Warren also attended John Hopkins University and was awarded a certificate of Advanced Study.


Upon completing Army ROTC in 1968 at NC A&T State University, he served four years in the US Army as Captain in the Intelligence Division in Baltimore, MD.
